Chapter One

Special Performances and Parades

General Description

Description:

Macy's Day Parade:

Riders who wish to ride in the Macy's Day Parade must be at least **level 2** and will be required to attend the mandatory practice(s) before the parade in order to learn the formations and receive their costumes. These riders will be required to RSVP prior to these practice(s).

Bike Expo:

The Junior directors will choose riders to represent each discipline that they would like to showcase at the expo and they would be required to attend 1 mandatory practice (either a Tuesday or a Wednesday) prior to the show. They would not have to be part of the performance squad.

Other events:

Riders who wish to ride in the Macy's Day Parade must be at least **level 2** and will be required to attend the mandatory practice(s) before the parade in order to learn the formations and receive their costumes. These riders will be required to RSVP prior to these practice(s).

Exceptions:

Exception can be made on a per-rider basis in cases of conflicting with school or academic related activities. Exceptions may be approved by the board by emailing board@snoqualmievalleyuncycleclub.org.

Eligibility to Ride

General Description

Description:

This policy describes the requirements each rider must meet in order to ride on any given practice. If all of these provisions are met, the Practice Manager still has the final say in whether or not a rider may ride in the gym. If there are outstanding behavior issues or concerns the Practice Manager will determine whether the rider may or may not ride.

Policy Provisions

① All forms have been completed and have been received by the club

Description:

- Concussion Form
- Rider code of Conduct (**must have signed copy by the second week of practice.**)

1.1. Concision form signed by rider or parent or guardian if less than 18 years of age.

1.2. SVUC terms and conditions have been agreed to

Description:

For online registrations this is done online. If the user has logged into WildApricot at least once then they will have completed this. If not then they can accept the terms manually by signing our terms and conditions by paper. See Also: Accepting new Walkin Memberships

② All membership dues have been paid in full.

Description:

This will be checked upon the first week. Also the Practice Manager can look up a member's payment status in the WildApricot phone app. Rider can ride so long as the membership is settled by end of practice.

③ If rider is less that level 5 then the rider must have a helmet to ride.

Description:

Rider level can be checked by going into the WildApricot app and looking up the rider contact USA level.

Rider code of conduct

General Description

Description:

SVUC is a sports club that is organized around the unicycle and unicycle excellence. When you come to practice you should be ready to work and improve your unicycle skills. Thus, in doing so have fun with your teammates!

Rider code of conduct:

- 1. Listen attentively to the practice manager.**
 - a. The practice manager has the final word on all activities in the gym.
 - b. If the practice manager tell you to stop, stop immediately.
- 2. Team practices are for practicing and improving your skills at the unicycle.**
 - a. Any horseplay or dangerous behavior will not be tolerated.
 - b. Hanging around or playing on computers/devices is not allowed. When you are at practice you are there ride and improve your skills.
- 3. Be considerate of your fellow riders**
 - a. Pay extra attention to beginning riders and try to stay out of their way.
 - b. Do not ride faster than your ability allows
 - c. If the gym is crowded keep your speed down to prevent collisions
- 4. Always support your fellow riders**
 - a. Bullying or mean spirited behavior will not be tolerated
 - b. Profanity of any sort will not be tolerated
- 5. Wear proper clothing and equipment**
 - a. Rubber soled tennis or sport shoes are required. If you do not wear this sort of shoe, you will have to sit out.
 - b. Clothing with profanity, inappropriate language, or hate speech written on it will not be tolerated.
 - c. Helmets are required for riders that are less than level 5.
